## TPPK 2012-2013 Enrollment

Enrollment packets went out on January 17<sup>th</sup>. ALL APPLICATIONS are due into the office by FEBRUARY 2. Below are the offerings for this year.

### *Tuition and Fees*

#### **Tuition**

2-day programs: \$160/month (2 year olds)

3-day programs: \$200/month (3 year olds)

4 day programs: \$255/month (Pre K)

5 day program: \$295/month (with assistant) (Kindergarten)

#### **Registration Fee**

A non-refundable registration fee of \$100 is due at the time of application. Each additional sibling is \$50.

#### **Supply Fee**

A once-per-year supply fee is payable in September.

2-day programs: \$75

3-day programs: \$90

4-day programs: \$110

5-day program: \$120

#### **May Prepaid Tuition**

A one-month tuition deposit, the regular May tuition payment, is paid in advance. This deposit is non-refundable, according to the terms specified in the parent/school contract.
