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TPPK 2012-2013 Enrollment

Enrollment packets will go out on January 17th. You will have the chance to talk with your teacher at conferences on Friday, January 20 about your child's placement for next year. ALL APPLICATIONS are due into the office by FEBRUARY 1. We are currently taking 2 year old applications. Below are the offerings for this year.

Tuition and Fees

Tuition

2-day programs: \$160/month (2 year olds)

3-day programs: \$200/month (3 year olds)

4 day programs: \$255/month (Pre K)

5 day program: \$295/month (with assistant) (Kindergarten)

Registration Fee

A non-refundable registration fee of \$100 is due at the time of application.

Each additional sibling is \$50.

Supply Fee

A once-per-year supply fee is payable in September.

2-day programs: \$75

3-day programs: \$90

4-day programs: \$110

5-day program: \$120

May Prepaid Tuition

A one-month tuition deposit, the regular May tuition payment, is paid in advance. This deposit is non-refundable, according to the terms specified in the parent/school contract.
