If you have not ordered your Sally Foster gift wrap, it's not too late! Use the link on the TPPK home page and place your order. Please share this information with your family and friends!

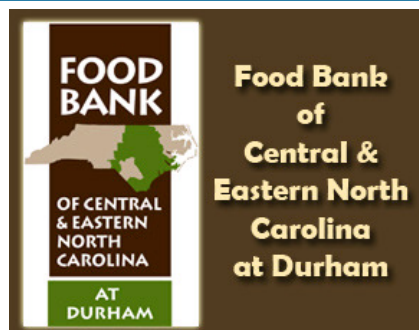
